

Covenant Israel Manuscript Symbols

(starting at the center)

- Parchment paper - From the Near East
- Silhouette - Savior behind all promises made
- Circle - Symbol of Heaven
 - Compass used to circumscribe a circle, one great whole, one Eternal Round
- Square - Symbol of Earth, exactness, uprightness, making covenants
 - Circle within Square - Heaven & Earth together - temple symbol
- Tree - Roots, Family Heritage, Growth, Fruitfulness
- Home - Placed where Heaven and earth meet and God is present
- Bridge at bottom - Christ as the mediator between Heaven and earth
 - descended below all
- Gold and Blue - Symbolic priesthood colors (Exodus 39:30-31)
- Olive branches -
 - House of Israel - allegory of the olive tree
 - The Fruits born of covenant living
 - The light of the world
 - Candles mentioned in the bible were actually oil lamps
 - Anciently olives were the main source of Light
 - Where that oil comes from - The olive Press - Gethsemane
 - The atonement is the source of the oil we carry in our lamps
- Lilies Stamp - same one used on the Savior's robe (Consider the lilies)
 - 4 places- the gathering of Israel from the four corners of the earth
